The Guide Crew of Pack String Ranch Outfitters is very excited to announce its intention to host a fantastic Mountain Mule Deer hunting opportunity for four Wounded Warrior Veterans. The hunt will take place on a private land ranch in Conifer Colorado, just one hour west of Denver and is provisionally scheduled for mid November 2010.

I am sure that many of you like me, have deep respect and gratitude for those who have served and defended our country. It is to show our appreciation for their sacrifice that we at Pack String Ranch Outfitters have decided to offer this opportunity to individuals wounded in service to their country.

I remember very clearly a day in my life when I was only 13 years old. It was 1970 and my older brother, who was also my hero, shook my hand, and hugged my parents, and departed to Vietnam. He served his tour of duty, and came back to us healthy, however so many were not so fortunate. Likewise many of our service members have returned from duty in Iraq and Afghanistan over the last decade with terrible injuries that include the loss of limbs, severe burns, traumatic brain injury and Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. It is our hope that this hunt will bring some welcome recreation and relaxation for four such individuals but we cannot do it alone. We hope that you too may be looking for a way to express your gratitude and will consider join with us in this endeavor. Here are some ways that you can join with us in this project to bring an enjoyable, possibly once in a lifetime hunting experience to a wounded US veteran:

1. We are looking for individuals or businesses to help defray financing costs for hosting these hunts. Pack String already has volunteer guides and cooks for the duration of the hunt; however, we are seeking donations to help cover the costs of land leases, food and insurance.

2. We will be soliciting a film crew to record the event. We will not be able to pay for this service, but hope to allow it to be shown on TV so that others can watch the event.
3. We are seeking equipment and apparel sponsors willing to furnish equipment for this hunting event.

Our goal for this event is to host at least one veteran from the Vietnam era, and three veterans from the “Global War on Terrorism” or modern wars in Iraq and Afghanistan.

This could truly be a dream come true for these veterans and we hope that you will consider assisting us in making this a reality.
